DUE PROCESS

N.Y. CONST. art. I, § 6:

No person shall be deprived of life, liberty or property without due process of law.

U. S. CONST. amend. V:

No person shall . . . be deprived of life, liberty, or property, without due process of law

U.S. CONST. amend. XIV, § 1:

No State shall . . . deprive any person of life, liberty, or property, without due process of law

COURT OF APPEALS

Fosmire v. Nicoleau¹⁹⁹
(decided January 18, 1990)

See the case analysis under FREE EXERCISE OF RELIGION.²⁰⁰ The court agreed that plaintiff's due process rights were violated because she was not given notice and an opportunity to be heard when a hospital obtained a court order to administer life sustaining blood transfusions against her wishes.²⁰¹
